# Meeting Minutes of the December 15, 2021 Meeting This meeting was held via ZOOM.

# 1. C800 Board Meeting Called to Order at 0901.

# 3. Approval of Minutes – November 17, 2021 Board Meeting

Chief Jim Davis moved, and Chief john Schmerber seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

# 4. Public Comment: None.

5. Communications: None.

# 6. Financial Report – November 2021 - John Hartsock

John reported that the report was included in the package and nothing unusual. No further questions were asked.

John Hartsock motioned to acknowledge the financial report, Lt. Mike Penunuri second. No Discussion. Motion Passed.

# 7. Committee Reports

Executive Committee – Chief Rick Huffman: Nothing to report.

**Technical Committee - John Hartsock:** There was no meeting on November 24<sup>th</sup>. Instead, the technical group met at CCOM met to see what was involved in separating consoles for COVID. There is a plan put together for that. The next meeting will be on December 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**Citizen Accountability - John Hartsock:** The meeting is this evening. We will go over most of the same things we talk about here today as far as project status.

# 8. Old Business:

**System Management - Ron Polluconi:** Generally speaking, the system is stable. Crew going up to Goat Mountain today just for a little extra safety margin. Everything buttoned up for winter. Reminder that we are running on T1s – which tie the analog and dispatch systems together regionally. They are linear, which means they are not protected. So, if one goes out, we can lose the segment of the system which it feeds, or a dispatch center for a time. Asked microwave design group to protect as many paths as possible against weather outages. We will meet again later this morning to discuss. Will get a final report out once there is a strategy.

John Schmerber asked the question- When we cut over will we have same issues? Ron answered with a qualified no. There won't be as many issues other than Timberline.

# System Upgrade/Replacement

**Project Status/Procurement – Bjorn Morfin / John Hartsock:** Bjorn reported that the Tom, Dick, and Harry site work has been suspended until spring. Oak grove site is tested and ready. PGE going out tomorrow to get it connected. Should have full power by Friday. Whale head should be ready with power by the end of the week.

John reported the target turn on date was 12-8 but issues with neighboring agencies, especially Portland PD, pushed that back. There is an ISSI connection between Portland and the WCCCA C800 system in place that is in testing currently. There is a plan to have all of Portland Fire's boundary station's apparatus reprogrammed by the go live date. There may be a bit of a delay on East County, but they think they may be able to have them ready as well. Portland PD looking to approve a transitional radio template. Clackamas units going into Portland will work just like it does today. Portland units coming into Clackamas County may be an issue though. Portland Dispatch will be able to patch CCOM, LOCOM and WCCCA talk groups.

Ron Polluconi added that there are three talk group for law enforcement that have been created for patching on the Portland system. From there they can be patched to a varied number of talk groups on our system. Portland fire will have radios programed and will operate just as we do today. Outlying agencies will still operate on a patch. The patch is designed into the system to work.

Portland PD and some Multnomah County Sheriffs will use patches. Portland's intent is to get precincts closest to Clackamas programed and will work way in. Estimating closer to end of January for everything, but edge precincts they believe will be done by the proposed cutover date.

John said he couldn't get everyone to say it will absolutely happen on January 11<sup>th</sup> yesterday, but it is looking very probable.

John Schmerber has great concern about potential failures going beyond 30 days.

Sue Scobert says Gresham Fire, TriMet and one other agency are already ready. Portland Fire will be ready on go live date and they said yesterday they can have 40% of Portland PD done by focusing on those that touch Clackamas County. So with the ISSI and the ability to patch we have mitigated most of the concerns.

Cheryl Bledsoe thinks new go live date will be good. The old date would have had issues. Discussion made John feel better.

# **Project Cutover Report – John Hartsock**

John said Project budget included. Finalizing where we are on utilities and storm damage clean up.

**900-800 Paging - Ron Polluconi:** Ron said no changes. Contract is ready to roll with Prism and the new controller element should be integrated into our overall system by March /April. Then we will begin to work on the P25 paging elements.

### Portable Radio Antenna- Ron Polluconi:

Continuing distribution to anyone that is ready. The Motorola symbol is colored in with silver sharpie on new antennas to identify that it is new. Radio serial number can be looked up to see if it needs to be swapped. It will make a difference at cutover.

### DVRS – Repeaters – Ron Polluconi:

No update. Gert Zoutendijk is in the process of setting up meetings for user input from other agencies that are using this. One is in the DC area and the other in British Columbia.

#### PSAP Questions/Concerns – CCOM/LOCOM:

Neither agency had any.

As consideration for an additional contribution paid by the **Named Participant**, in the amount of **\$3,108.00**, the **Property Coverage Document** is amended as follows:

  - c. collapse directly caused by earth movement.



- **3. Earth movement** does not mean, and we will not indemnify you or anyone else for, damage caused by, resulting from, or consisting of:
  - **a.** Gradual cracking, crumbling, horizontal, lateral or vertical movement, rising, shifting, settling, sinking, or upheaval of **land**, occurring over a period of fourteen or more days, caused by, or arising out of artificial means or artificially created soil conditions, including contraction, corrosion, erosion, excessive or insufficient moisture, expansion, freezing, improperly compacted soil, insufficient fill, liquefaction, slope instability, slumping, subsidence, or thawing;
  - **b.** Gradual cracking, crumbling, horizontal, lateral or vertical movement, rising, shifting, settling, sinking, or upheaval of **land**, occurring over a period of fourteen or more days, caused by, or arising out of underground activity of animals, vegetation, or **water**; or
  - c. any water movement or flood, except for flood that would not have occurred but for tsunami caused by, resulting from, or arising out of earth movement as described in section XII.L.2. above.
- 4. All earth movement that occurs within a 72-hour period will constitute a single occurrence.
- 5. **9.** Any amounts paid under this **Coverage Extension** are included in, subject to, and not in any event in addition to, the **Total Limit of Indemnification** stated in the Declarations.

This Endorsement only amends Section XII. Coverage Extensions of the Property Coverage Document, and does not modify, amend, waive or otherwise affect any of the other terms, conditions, limitations, exceptions, or exclusions of the Property Coverage Document.
