#### 3. Approval of Minutes – February 16, 2022, Board Meeting

Chief Corless moved and Chief Mahuna seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 6. Financial Report – February 2022 - John Hartsock

Chief Corless moved and Captain Wurpes seconded to acknowledge the report. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 7. Call the FY 2022/2023 Budget Committee Meeting to order

#### a) Present the FY 2022/2023 Proposed Budget – John Hartsock

John reported that the annual per radio cost was the same as last year. There was an increase in radio count. HBC maintenance is up from last year mostly attributed to the new sites that were added. The cost allocation per agency increased or decreased based on radio count.

Chief Davis asked where the bond savings account was accounted for in this budget? John said that it's shown in this budget as part of the Capital Budget. It's not broken down in this budget as its broken down in the project budget. It's still being audited with the accountant and there is five years' worth of data to go through. He will have it before the end of March. There is about \$4 million left of work to go. Chief Davis was concerned that this information was not available yet and asked for a deadline. John said it will be ready by the end of March.

Sue asked when the accounting is done the end of March, is there still outstanding project costs? John said yes, it will take until fall before all the items are checked off and completed. There is still a fair amount of work left to do that they are scheduling with vendors. He estimated it wouldn't be completed until August or September. Ron agreed.

#### b) Recommendation of the FY 2022/2023 Proposed Budget

Sue Scobert made a motion and Lt. Penuri seconded to move the proposed budget forward. A vote was cast and all approved except Chief Davis. Chief Davis said he is not in support and he won't be voting in favor of the budget until they receive that data at the end of March. He voted against the motion. No other opposition.

#### Motion passed.

#### The March 16, 2022, C800 Board of Directors meeting was reconvened.

#### 8. Committee Reports

Executive Committee – Jorge Tro: No updates.

**Technical Committee - John Hartsock:** John reported that they met on February 23 and went over system and site issues. They discussed the console moves from CCOM. Next meeting is March 23.

**Citizen Accountability - John Hartsock:** John shared that they need the audit information before they could meet again so the next meeting is to be determined.

#### 9. Old Business:

#### System Management – Ron Polluconi

Sites continue to be stable. They had a single antenna failure along Hwy 26 which is now replaced. They are in the middle of their system upgrade. The biggest impact to users will be on March 23 and 24. On March 23, there will be a cutover outage for five minutes at 0400, 0430, and 0500. On March 24 at 1600 will be the final outage. The outages are to finish the upgrades. He will send out a schedule with these upcoming events. He doesn't anticipate these outages to be largely impactful to users.

#### **Radio Use Issues**

The techs have been investigating radio issues utilizing the online reporting system. (Can be accessed here: <u>https://clackamasfire.jotform.com/220596761771060</u>)

They plan on doing a drive test later that day on Hwy 213 as there were three reports of issues in that area.

The issues have been falling into a few categories including audio levels and garbled transmissions. For audio issues, they have been testing all the accessories. The cutout issues have greatly decreased. They made a system change to minimize the impact of interference.

There has also been issues with Life Flight radios. They are going to reach out to them directly as Ron and his team do no program Life Flight's radios. He'll be working with them to determine if the issues are programming or training related.

Chief Davis asked when Ron and his team were going to come to Canby? They have been having issues with radio strength which can be a major firefighter safety issue. Ron said he thinks that is set up for Friday afternoon.

Toni Sexton was concerned if she was sending too much information over or not enough. Ron told her that the information she is sending is great and not to change it.

#### Home Button Reprogramming

The techs are working on this going from smaller to larger agencies so they started with the outlying areas. This programming requires a lot of coordination from the agency.

The methods that they are using are three-prong: direct cable, over the air, and Wi-fi. They are able to get a majority of radios programmed via Wi-fi and through direct cable and they are scheduling the over the air updates. He feels this process has been successful so far. They are working their way up to larger agencies.

Shaun described multiple issues on a call that caused critical safety concerns. Ron said that that training was completed with his organization and a training video was shared. He is happy to direct him to those resources. They are also scheduled for a visit and Ron's team will be by very soon. John shared that there were three reports from that incident and they are being reviewed and will report back to them.

#### **Streaming Delay**

The company doing the recording is doing the streaming. They are streaming to a service which is one of the most common services out there. However, they are having a problem on the engineering side on the recorders to present the delay. They've had to create their own set up to work on this issue. He hopes to have a deployment schedule out in about 6 weeks.

#### 800 MHz Voice Paging

Ron said they are still waiting on the paging controller. They hope to do acceptance tests in late May. They've had two web meetings with Prism, and it looks to be a straightforward process. They bought an interface box that provides voice paging over the P25 system. He hopes to implement that early summer.

#### System Upgrade/Replacement

#### Project Status/Procurement – Bjorn Morfin / John Hartsock:

John reported that they are waiting for the snow to clear so they can finish Whalehead, Oak Grove, and TD&H.

**DVRS** – **repeaters** – **Gert Zoutendijk:** John said that Gert had a meeting with the committee and looked at additional frequencies. Ron shared that they discussed if there were enough frequencies and how tightly packed would the reuse of those frequencies be.

# 2022/2023 BUDGET MESSAGE

## BACKGROUND

The City of Canby, City of Gladstone, City of Lake Oswego, City of Milwaukie, City of Molalla, City of Oregon City, City of Sandy, City of West Linn, Aurora Fire District, Aurora Fire District, Canby Fire District, Clackamas Fire District Number 1, Colton Fire District, Estacada Fire District, Hoodland Fire District, Molalla Fire District, Sandy Fire District, Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue, Clackamas County Sheriff, Clackamas County Health (herein after "Partners") manage an ORS 190 organization named CLACKAMAS 800 RADIO GROUP (C800). The purpose of the CLACKAMAS 800 RADIO GROUP is to own and operate an effective and cost efficient 800MHz public safety communications system to support public safety to benefit and protect the citizens of Clackamas County.

The organizational and governance format provides an effective approach to public safety communications benefiting law enforcement, fire fighters, emergency medical service providers and the public they serve through a cooperative, partner-managed, information sharing, and communication systems/operations.

This is the thirteenth budget for C800. An initial budget was prepared in FY 2001/2002 but due to the system not being completed there were no operational funds expended. The system became operational in FY 2002/2003 and operational funds were collected and expended.

Clackamas County provided C800 the funding to construct the original 10 site 800MHz radio system. The C800 partners repaid the County through operating funds. In 2016 Clackamas County on behalf of C800 placed a ballot measure on the ballot for the voters of the County to authorize a \$59M general obligation bond to upgrade and expand the system. The measure passed with a 70% margin of approval. The upgrade project to move the system to P25 digital from analog and expand the system by 14 sites is 90% complete and is operating.

Washington County Consolidated Communications Agency (WCCCA) provides technical management and maintains the radio system under an Intergovernmental Agreement.

## **GOAL**

The goal of C800 is to provide:

"AN EFFECTIVE PUBLIC SAFETY VOICE AND DATA RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM OPERATING AT MAXIMUM EFFICIENCY -- DELIVERING QUALITY SERVICE -- IN THE MOST COST EFFECTIVE MANNER."



## FUNCTION OF THE CLACKAMAS 800 RADIO GROUP

CLACKAMAS 800 RADIO GROUP performs the following functions:

- A. Implementation of goals and objectives as established by the C800 Board of Directors including development and implementation of long-range plans to the extent funds are appropriated for that purpose by the Partners.
- B. Adoption of an annual budget and approval of budget modifications as required.
- C. Review and evaluate efforts for effectiveness and conformance with established objectives short and long term.
- D. Approval of new Partners.
- E. Approval of Members who will utilize the radio system and determination of a fee schedule for this use.
- F. Approval of future phases of the Radio System build out including funding strategies for capital and operating costs, recognizing that this power of C800 does not obligate the Partners to participate in the funding or management of future phases assets.
- G. Select and retain personnel as deemed appropriate or required for C800's operations.
- H. Resolve operating problems of the Radio System as brought before the C800 Board.

## **EXPLANATION OF BUDGET**

To enable C800 to perform the above, the Board has directed that a budget be prepared as is allowed under statue for the ORS 190 organization. This is a "Council of Government Budget Process" per ORS 294.900 through ORS 294.930 (as amended 2012). As an ORS 190 organization, CLACKAMAS 800 RADIO GROUP is not permitted to levy taxes.

The revenue for the agency is derived from its Partner contributions, fees and charges instituted for other system users, site use agreements with other entities, grants, and loans.

The Board has adopted a funding formula based upon the number of radios programmed on the system. This formula takes the approved operating cost for C800 and divides it by the number of radios programmed onto the system. This per radio cost is then multiplied against the number of radios programmed by a particular agency on the system thus deriving that agency's cost.

## FINANCIAL POLICY

The financial policy of C800 is to run a fiscally sound cost conscience as well as an effective customer service organization. C800 operates on a modified accrual basis for accounting. The Board authorized the retention of the firm Talbot, Korvola, & Warwick, LLP to provide accounting services. One of the C800 Partners provides oversight of payments made on C800's behalf.



C800's budget is being used to operate and maintain the radio system as well as to shape the agency and determine its long-term mission and objectives. Washington County Consolidated Communications Agency (WCCCA) provides technical system management and maintenance of the radio system through an Intergovernmental Agreement with C800.

Personnel loaned by the Partners, consultants, and various vendors perform other duties and services required. Currently there are no personnel retained by the C800 as employees.

## FINANCIAL POLICY FEATURES

As outlined above services for the agency will be contracted for or provided by other governmental entities, private sector resources, or Partner agencies by direction of the Board. Likewise, the Board will approve material and service costs as required.

## **CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BUDGET**

The following outlines the changes from the approved FY 2021/2022. Materials and Services has increased by 4.4%. Changes include a) Site rental by 3% due to added sites and lease escalation b) HVAC Maintenance by 8.3% due to added sites c) Landscape maintenance by 7.5% due to added sites d) Generator Maintenance due to added sites 16% e) Insurance cost 9.7% f) Building maintenance by 40% due to added buildings g) Utility costs by 4.8% h) WCCCA system fees have increased 7.7% due to escalation.

C800 and WCCCA are jointly working on the radio replacement project which has upgraded the old radio system from analog to digital, improved coverage, and enhancing performance. This project was required due to system age, technology advancements, and the inability to support the old system into the future. The system is now operational and all work will be completed this calendar year.

The per radio cost has stayed the same at \$480.

## CHANGES IN FINANCIAL POLICY

The financial policy has been approved by Board and there have been no changes.



## **CONCLUSION**

Clackamas 800 Radio Group continues to be an excellent opportunity for the political and public safety jurisdictions; and public safety answering points and dispatch centers; fire and law enforcement and emergency medical service providers; and the citizens of Clackamas County, its Cities and Districts served by C800. As outlined above C800 is participating with WCCCA in implementing the upgrade to the Public Safety voice and data radio system across Clackamas and Washington County.
