- 4. Motion was made by Ryan Hari to ratify the actions of the August 10, 2016 meeting. Motion was seconded by Jim Davis and passed unanimously.

- 6. Communications: None
- 7. **Financial Report John Hartsock:** Financial report for July and August 2016 was distributed and presented. Everything is tracking as it should. New accounted now has online access to the bank documents to be able to provide monthly financial reports in a timelier fashion.

8. Committee Reports:

- a. Executive Committee Fred Charlton
 - i. Chief Charlton was absent. Executive committee has not met since the last meeting.
- b. Technical John Hartsock
 - i. Committee will be meeting in two weeks.

9. Old Business:

- a. System Management Ron Polluconi
 - i. Currently in a pre-winter prevention cycle. Will be fueling tanks next month.
 - ii. Failure rates are up slightly with repeaters.
- Expansion of East County System Estacada/Molalla John Hartsock / Ron Polluconi
 - i. Construction is nearly complete. Working on securing the facility and fencing will be up in coming weeks.
 - ii. Pre-stage microwave is in the shop. ETA on installation is about three weeks.
 - iii. Kudos due HPS Construction, they are doing very good site construction.
- c. System Upgrade/Replacement
 - i. Microwave Upgrade Status Ron Polluconi
 - 1. All RF cutover complete for C800. There will be a slight impact to CCOM when the final WCCCA cut over is performed. So far there have been no reliability issues.
 - 2. Currently working on improving signal strength and final sign off.
 - ii. Project procurement strategy John Hartsock
 - A handout was provided in response to Chief Yamashita's letter concerning a sole source procurement. C800 is continuing to track WCCCA/Washington County and their approach to a sole source procurement.
 - 2. As part of the project plan we accounted for growth and normal accessories for the portion of radios furnished with bond dollars.
 - 3. Discussion of audit done by WSP on their sole source procurement.
 - 4. Ron and John are available to meet with city managers, councils, etc. to discuss their concerns.
 - iii. Status of Clackamas County IGA / Bond Sale Laurel Butman
 - 1. Bond sale is currently scheduled for the beginning of December.
 - 2. Currently working on the IGA between C800 and the County.
 - iv. Site Acquisition Status John Hartsock
 - 1. Process is proceeding as anticipated. Meeting with the city of Sandy and Canby have been scheduled.
 - 2. Hoping to get direction this week on the BLM on sites from BLM.
 - 3. National Forest Service has released us to do environmental work which can only be done in the spring.
 - 4. Working on finding a site in Damascus.

- v. Encryption Update Chief Charlton
 - 1. Chief Charlton is absent, but there is a memo included in the handout packet.
 - Clackamas County Fire Defense Board met with Washington County's Fire Defense Board and the talk is to move forward with encryption capable radios, but no decision has been made yet on which talk groups would be encrypted.
- vi. Citizen Committee / Appointment John Hartsock
 - 1. Have reviewed the citizens who have submitted their interest.

 There were 11 applicants, and these have been narrowed down to 8 applicants which geographically represent the County.
 - 2. Motion made by Vince Stafford to approve the 8 applicants to the committee, motion was seconded by Neil Hennelly and passed unanimously.
- vii. Project Management Contract Award John Hartsock
 - 1. Intent to award the contract to Ken Seemore and his firm (3dB Consulting).
 - Not finished with the fee negotiation and work scope, will bring back to the board next month.
- d. Colton Fire Partnership Status
 - 1. Colton ready to move forward.

Re: Approval of Microwave Networks Equipment Purchase

REQUEST: It is hereby requested that the C800 Board of Directors approve a purchase in the amount of \$58,615 with Microwave Networks to furnish and install a microwave equipment between the Sawtell site and the Goat Mtn site.

ISSUE: In order to make the Sawtell site operational we need to establish a microwave connection to the Goat Mtn site to place the Sawtell site on the network.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The furnishing and installation of 2 microwave radios and associated antenna and power systems at 2 tower sites. This microwave equipment is compatible with the new system recently installed for C800.

The C800 project cost is \$58,615.

In accordance with ORS 279B.070 this is an intermediate procurement. When conducting an intermediate procurement, a contracting agency shall seek at least three informally solicited competitive price quotes or competitive proposals from prospective contractors. The contracting agency shall keep a written record of the sources of the quotes or proposals received. If three quotes or proposals are not reasonably available, fewer will suffice, but the contracting agency shall make a written record of the effort the contracting agency makes to obtain the quotes or proposals.

Staff contacted Microwave Networks / Ericson Microwave / Aviat Microwave / Alcatel Microwave and only received a quote from Microwave Networks. Pricing was verified on HGAC and NASPO, both national purchasing cooperatives, which contained pricing for Aviat and Alcatel and those prices were higher than the quoted price from Microwave Networks.

FINANCE: The funds are budgeted as a part of the Radio Upgrade Project and are part of the bond funding.

LEGAL: A C800 purchase order will be utilized as approved by legal counsel.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the C800 Board of Directors approve a purchase in the amount of \$58,615 with Microwave Networks to furnish and install a microwave equipment between the Sawtell site and the Goat Mtn site.
