1. **C800 Board Meeting Called to Order:** The C800 Board of Directors meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by Chair Chief Fred Charlton.

- **3. Approval of Minutes September 14, 2016 Board Meeting:** A motion was made by Mark Havener to approve the minutes and seconded by Neil Hennelly. A unanimous vote was cast to approve the minutes.
- 4. Public Comment: None
- 5. Communications: None
- **6. Financial Report John Hartsock:** Financial report is included in the packet. We are tracking on budget and there are no concerns.
- 7. Committee Reports:
 - a. Executive Committee Fred Charlton
 - i. The Executive Committee did not meet. Did send an email communication looking for a fire and law liaison to the citizen advisory committee. Bob Morissey from Estacada Fire will serve as fire liaison but we are still looking for a law liaison and would like one by November.
 - b. Technical John Hartsock
 - i. Group will be meeting today.

8. Old Business:

- a. System Management Ron Polluconi
 - i. Nothing too substantial to report. We are in the process of completing preventative maintenance and should be completed in time for winter.
- b. Expansion of East County System Molalla John Hartsock / Ron Polluconi
 - i. There have some slight delays from PGE which has delayed getting power to the site will be resolved this week. The tower is complete and the antennas are up; and the rest of construction is virtually done. We are waiting on a few last items.
 - ii. Radio-wise we are set to go. The microwave path study will be completed on Friday. Equipment is on order. It will take about 2 weeks to the installation.
- c. System Upgrade/Replacement John Hartsock / Ron Polluconi
 - i. Microwave Upgrade Status Ron Polluconi
 - 1. Fundamentally done, just waiting on the final acceptance test data. We do have a few values that are outside of what we expected but nothing critical. Operationally is has been performing flawlessly with no connectivity issues.
 - ii. Project procurement strategy John Hartsock
 - 1. We are continuing to follow WCCCA's lead on the radio procurement. They had a meeting with lobbyists from Harris to review questions. WCCCA and Washington County are determining how to move forward. Planing to close it out before the year is over.
 - iii. Status of Clackamas County IGA / Bond Sale John Hartsock
 - 1. Received a draft of the IGA between the County and C800 yesterday and forwarded to Eileen Eakins (C800 legal counsel). Looks good, nothing exciting or strange. Will try to bring it back for approval in November.
 - 2. Bond interest and millage rate as proposed is still accurate and hoping it may even be less but we won't know more until next month when the bonds are sold.
 - iv. Site Acquisition Status John Hartsock
 - 1. Moving along nicely. We are having some of the environmental study's as it relates to the Highland and Crutcher's sites completed. Final application packets should be in to BLM within a month. We will begin the environmental studies in the spring for the USFS sites and we probably won't hear anything until April or May.
 - 2. The lease has been signed for Sandy and the survey work is done. We are set for a neighborhood meeting on November 1st in Canby. We now have a site in Damascus that looks promising. So only the

- Carver site is left. Wilsonville's lease is done but having issues with tower height and may have to move to the adjacent lot.
- 3. We agreed to link with Aurora to their dispatch center with the microwave. We are waiting to hear from Salem to see if they want to use our core for their system which will affect the outcome.
- d. Colton Fire John Hartsock, Gary Anderson ask for a copy of the IGA.

9. New Business:

- a. Sawtell Microwave Contract Award John Hartsock
 - i. The microwave radios for Sawtell are being purchased off existing contracts C800 has with the vendor but we are comparing pricing off national group purchases to ensure competitive costs.
 - ii. A motion was made to approve the purchase by James Rhodes and seconded by Neil Hennelly. A unanimous vote was cast to approve the microwave network equipment purchase.
- b. Site Use Agreement with PGE for Timberline John Hartsock.
 - i. PGE approached us because they are building a new radio system to serve their entire service area. They were interested in our sites that are in the USFS area. They wanted to know how we could partner. We are going to allow them use and they will pay for microwave transport.
 - ii. Co-location policy is available with a rate schedule for anyone interested but for security reasons we usually prefer not to. It is a case by case evaluation.
 - iii. A motion was made by Neil Hennelly to approve the purchase and seconded by Matt Ellington. A unanimous vote was cast to approve the PGE use of Timberline site.
- c. Next Board Meeting November 9, 2016 at CCOM/EOC

10. Open Agenda:

- a. Portland Radio Digital v. Analog
 - i. The only impacted site for Clackamas County will be the PCC Sylvania site. Fire only (to be verified), will need to have APEX radios for the north corner of the PCC campus near Lake Oswego. The Portland main system will continue to provide analog until C800/WCCCA go digital. Users will need to have digital capable radios in the two affected ASR sites PCC and Sylvan.
 - ii. Need to verify what would happen in case of an emergency at the campus regarding law enforcement and fire. Need to do further investigation to solve this potential issue.

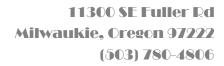

Re: Approval of Project Management Agreement

REQUEST: It is hereby requested that the C800 Board of Directors authorize entering a personnel services contract in an amount not to exceed \$297,000 with 3dB Communications Beaverton, Oregon to provide project management services for the Radio Upgrade Project.

ISSUE: As part of the Radio Upgrade Project the services of an independent Project Management firm have been included in the project planning and budgeting for the project. The Project Management firm will provide appropriate personnel to provide project oversight with key responsibility for schedule and budget management.

C800/WCCCA published a Request for Proposal for Project Management Services on May 26, 2016 and received twelve requests for the document and four proposals on June 23, 2016. The purpose of the Request for Proposals (Solicitation) was to obtain competitive offers from qualified Firms or Individuals interested in providing WCCCA/C800 with Communication System Upgrade Project Management Services.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The Provider shall provide organizational skills, management oversight, and fiscal control in an expeditious and economical manner consistent with the interests of the overall project. The Provider's primary responsibility is managing the successful implementation of all key project elements of the Communications System Replacement Project and will include but are not limited to the following:

- i. Communications site acquisition, development, construction and provisioning in compliance with the most current Motorola R56 Standards and Guidelines for Communications Sites.
- ii. Upgrading existing communications sites to comply with new design needs and or regulatory or land use requirements. (R56 compliant upgrades, essential facilities, tower loading and or related revisions)
- iii. AC power generation and DC power and backup systems.
- iv. Microwave backhaul systems (IP and TDM technologies)
- v. Network management systems, security, telemetry, alarms and surveillance
- vi. Wireless Ethernet connectivity to key public safety facilities (IP underlay)
- vii. P25 Land Mobile Radio subscriber equipment receipt, inventory control, programming/upgrades, distribution and installation as appropriate.

- viii. P25 Land Mobile Radio infrastructure scope of work (SOW) acceptance testing, shipping, installation, startup, optimization, systems performance and system coverage testing.
- ix. P25 Land Mobile Radio subscriber cut over and final acceptance testing/approval.
- x. Directly purchased and or supplier provided equipment inventories and reconciliation.

The four firms that provided proposals and their fee for both WCCCA and C800 were:

- 1. 3dB Communications Beaverton, OR \$692,640
- 2. Plan B Consultancy Lake Oswego, OR \$699,740
- 3. Gillespie, Prudhon & Assoc Clackamas, OR \$808,283
- 4. Compass Project Solutions Keizer, OR \$994,330

A four-person review team (Ron Polluconi / Jennifer Reeves / Jason Kirkpatrick / John Hartsock) evaluated the proposals based on the criteria outlined in the RFP document. Interviews were conducted on August 8th to determine a finalist. 3dB Communications was choosen.

FINANCE: The funds are budgeted as part of the Radio Project.

LEGAL: A C800 professional services contract as approved by legal counsel will be utilized.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the C800 Board of Directors authorize entering a personnel services contract in an amount not to exceed \$297,000 with 3dB Communications Beaverton, Oregon to provide project management services for the Radio Upgrade Project.
