Meeting Minutes of the March 18, 2020 Meeting Teleconference Only Meeting.

i. C800 Board Meeting Called to Order at 0900

ii. The following were in attendance:

iii. Approval of Minutes – February 19, 2020 Board Meeting

- **a.** Due to the lack of a quorum John suggested tabling this approval until the next meeting.
- iv. Public Comment: None.
- v. Communications: None.

vi. Financial Report

- **a.** John Hartsock shared that the financial report was included in the packet that was sent.
- **b.** He reported there was nothing unusual in the report. He explained they were tracking on budget for the year.

vii. *Presentation and Acceptance of the FY2020/2021 Proposed Budget – John Hartsock

- **a.** John requested a motion for the budget, even though there wasn't a quorum on the phone. He explained he would query the Board by email for the vote.
- **b.** John explained they had been able to maintain the per radio cost they had for the past two years.
- **c.** John stated that costs were down in a couple areas, while a couple other areas were up. He briefing explained some of the costs.
- **d.** John noted that the WCCCA system fees went down. He noted that this was partly because of getting more precise on radio counts. He shared that there were around 1100-1200 non-apex radios still out there that needed to get to WCCCA to de-programed. He explained that they needed to get them off the system to maintain an accurate radio count.
- **e.** John shared he was glad to answer any questions. He added that the budget was pretty straight forward; the same as other years.
- **f.** Randy Hopperstad make a motion to accept the budget. Mike Corless seconded the motion. John noted he would send an email for the vote.
 - *John later shared the voting results received via email. He noted that four of the 19 partners including: City of Milwaukie, City of West Linn, Hoodland Fire District and Clackamas County Health, did not respond. The remaining 15 partners voted yes, to accept the budget as presented. Since 15 was a majority of the partners, the motion passed.

viii. Committee Reports

- a. Executive Committee-Sue Scobert
 - Sue reported that they did not meet.
- b. Technical Committee-John Hartsock
 - John reported that they did not meet February. The next meeting was scheduled for March 25th
- c. Citizen Accountability- John Hartsock
 - John shared their next meeting was scheduled for April 21st at the Oregon City Library but was cancelled due to the Corona Virus. The meeting has been rescheduled for June 17, 2020 location to be determined.

ix. Old Business:

a. System Management- Ron Polluconi

- Ron shared that one of the controllers had been in and out, operationally, but that there had been no interruption in service. He added that tit was fixed last week and was being monitored carefully.
- Ron explained they were getting ready for pre-configurations for the microwave cut over, as they were getting prepared for blending the new microwaves to the sites that are up. He added that when they do that, they will need to blend the digital and analog systems together. He explained they were working on the pre-configurations, so they can make sure they don't have any glitches or issues.
- Ron stated that there was very little fall out with the rest of the system. He noted that generally speaking, the system was in pretty good shape.

b. System Upgrade/Replacement

- i. Project Status/Procurement-Bjorn
- Bjorn reported that in the past few months, a couple sites were completed. He explained that Hoodland Fire was complete and Wilsonville tank was complete. He noted that Highland Butte was complete, less the tower, which would be completed in the coming week.
- Bjorn explained they were continuing progress on the Memaloose power. He noted they were planning to get started soon with power at both Oak Grove and Whalehead. He added that they would need to wait until the snow was gone for the site completion.
- Bjorn shared that they were still waiting for a response from ODOT on the West Linn site. He explained they had an internal push with the wireless group. He hoped to hear something in the following week.
- Bjorn shared that almost everything was done on the existing sites, except for Goat Mountain. He explained there was quite a bit of work left on the upgrades at Goat Mountain.
- John shared that everything was pretty much lined up in regards to procurement.

ii. Fire Station Alerting/Paging – John Hartsock

- John shared that fire station alerting was moving along well with minimum issues.
- John reported that of the 45 stations in Clackamas County, they had 25 with the systems in, 21 that were signed off by US Digital, and 11 that were turned on.
- John explained that they would slow down a bit. He stated they would need to bring in a contractor to finish up some of the CFD #1 sites, because Nick Fisher had to go back on the line.
- John reported that it looked like the whole project would be completed in early July.
- Sue asked when US Digital would be back to do more check offs in the station. John answered that US Digital could come back as soon as they asked them to. He noted

that Sue had two stations. John shared he would touch base with Brian at TVF&R to see if he could get a couple other stations for US Digital to look at as well at the same time.

iii. Portable/Mobile Radio Deployment – Todd Matsuo

- Todd was not in attendance.
- John shared they had an updated schedule from Motorola.
- John explained that Motorola was continuing to upgrade existing radios.

iv. Portable Radio Antenna- Ron Polluconi

- Ron shared that the monoband antennas seemed to be going pretty well. He reported that they had been doing limited evaluations on the PMA 2020 series, and had generally positive results. He explained they were getting ready to plug those in, on a large quantity. He noted that if they continued to get good results, they would order these for a full replacement.
- Ron explained that for the triband antennas, a field test was done down in Los Angeles. He explained that they had some complications with the results and the test had provided very little data.
- Ron shared that it looked like for the multiband, they had gone back to the drawing board. He hoped to have more information in the coming week, after talking with the folks who had tested.
- John noted that the agency where they were doing the test in Los Angeles had a lot of similar terrain to ours. He thought it was a relevant test and a good comparison.

v. DVRS – repeaters – Ron Polluconi

- John shared that Chief Davis had a lot of concerns regarding the DVRS repeaters.
- John wondered if this topic should wait until there were more attendees. He asked if Ron would share some brief comments on the topic.
- Ron explained they had done some pre-programing work for Lake Oswego to do some evaluation work. He also noted that Hillsboro Fire had been doing some evaluation work. He stated that those were the two samples out there for folks to evaluate and test.
- Ron shared that they were not ready to push it out for production use.
- Ron explained that when the Motorola team was there, they did some evaluations, and there were more limitations than they originally thought.
- Ron shared it was limited potential for today's environment.
- Ron noted that he had not heard back from the Washington County side yet, regarding their evaluation.

vi. New Business: (*Action Item)

a. *Approval of contract with Evans Consoles

- **i.** John explained that the project would replace the consoles at both CCOM and LOCOM. However, he shared that LOCOM's order would come in the future. This action item would be for CCOM only.
- ii. John noted that CCOM did very extensive research.
- **iii.** John shared that the cost of the main brands were all in the same cost range and available through cooperative purchasing agreements.
- **iv.** John explained that funds were in the project. He explained that the recommendation was to approve the purchasing of the CCOM consoles.

- v. Mike Corless made a motion that the C800 Board of Directors approve purchasing console furniture for CCOM from Evans Console's Inc. Vienna, VA in the amount of \$377,004.42. Phil Schneider seconded the motion.
 - *John later shared the voting results received via email. He noted that four of the 19 partners, including: City of Milwaukie, City of West Linn, Hoodland Fire District and Clackamas County Health, did not respond. The remaining 15 partners voted yes, to accept the purchasing of the console furniture. Since 15 was the majority of the partners, the motion passed.

b. *Approval of Lt. Jorge Tro as a check signer.

- **i.** John noted that Bret Smith had explained that when he retired, Lt. Jorge Tro would come on and fill his position.
- **ii.** John noted that they needed meeting minutes to show that the Board approved Lt. Jorge Tro as a check signer.
- **iii.** Bret Smith explained that he filled out the form to remain in the position. He added that with the latest COVID-19 developments, vacancies were down. He explained that the transition could take a little longer and have a different date/time. He shared he could be a signer, if it was appropriate to have more than one, until the transition.
- **iv.** John shared that it would be fine to have Bret stay a signer as well. He suggested to go ahead and put Lt. Jorge Tro on as a signer, so it would be ready when the transition happened.
- w. Mike Corless made a motion for the C800 Board of Directors to authorize Lt. Jorge Tro as a check signer for the checking account at Clackamas County Bank (Account #733508). Phil Schneider seconded the motion.
 - *John later shared the voting results received via email. He noted that four of the 19 partners including: City of Milwaukie, City of West Linn, Hoodland Fire District and Clackamas County Health, did not respond. The remaining 15 partners voted yes, to authorize Lt. Jorge Tro as a check signer. Since 15 was the majority of the partners, the motion passed.

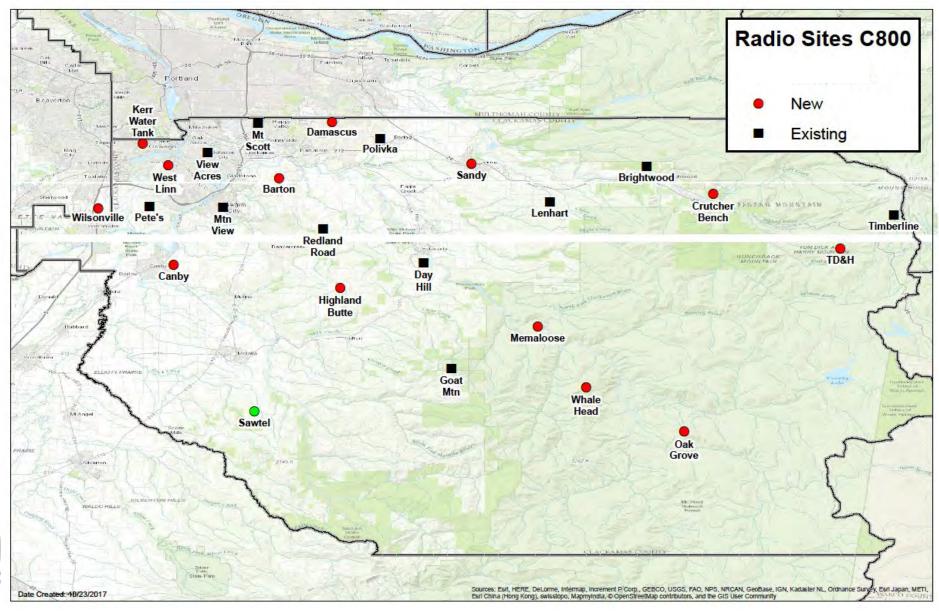

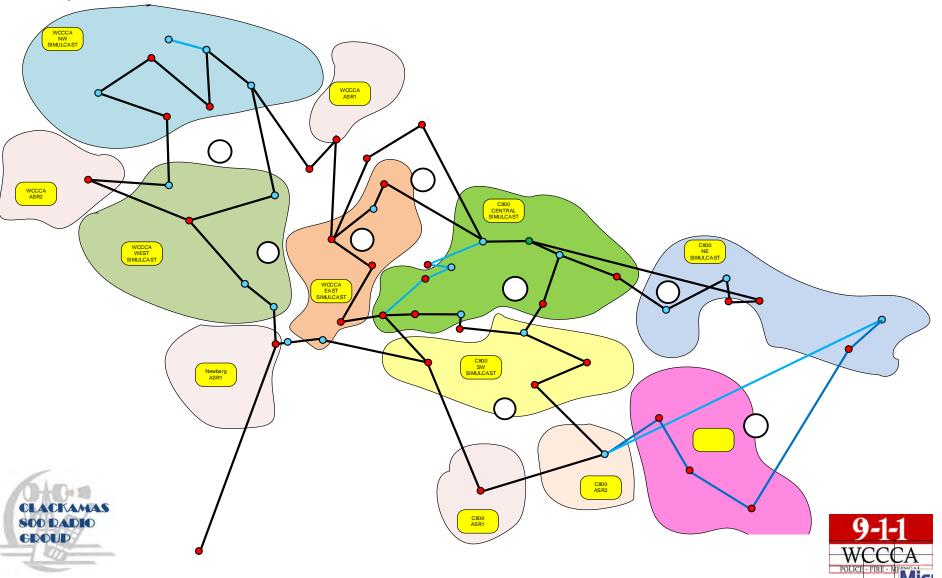

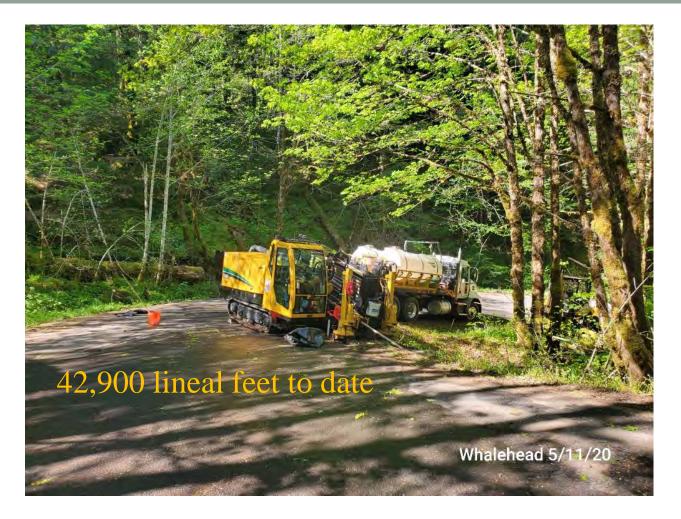

REQUEST: It is hereby requested that the C800 Board of Directors approve purchasing console furniture for LOCOM from Russ Bassett, Whitter CA in the amount of \$144,162.45.

DESCRIPTION: The existing console furniture at LOCOM which holds the radio system dispatch equipment is approaching 20 years old and is failing. As a part of the bond upgrade project the replacement of these consoles were included.

LOCOM did extensive research on console furniture with the following firms: Evans Consoles, Xybix Consoles (WCCCA), Russ Basset Consoles and others. After site visits and staff involvement and review LOCOM has chosen Russ Basset as the best fit for their needs.

In accordance with ORS 279A-205 this procurement is being facilitated through a cooperative purchasing agreement. Huston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) has entered into contract number EC07-18 on July 7, 2018 to June 30 2020 with Russ Bassett.

FINANCE: The funds are budgeted in capital outlay as part of the Bond funding.

LEGAL: A C800 purchase order will be utilized as approved by legal counsel.

RECOMMENDATION: It is hereby recommended that the C800 Board of Directors approve purchasing console furniture for LOCOM from Russ Bassett, Whitter CA in the amount of \$144,162.45.

REQUEST: It is hereby requested that the C800 Board of Directors approve issuing a contract amendment in the amount of \$80,000 to SecuraSite for additional site acquisition services.

DESCRIPTION: In September of 2015 C800/WCCCA issued a Request for Proposals for site acquisition and related support services to coordinate the acquisition of the additional new sites for the communications upgrade project. Five firms responded and after interviews and a careful evaluation of the proposals SecuraSite was chosen to provide these services for C800 and WCCCA.

On July 31, 2017 C800 and dB3 Communications mutually agreed to terminate dB3's contract for providing project management services for the project. In August 2017 C800 awarded SecuraSite a contract for providing project management and construction management services through December 2018. Due to project delays, not caused by SecuraSite, the contract was extended to December of 2019 and June 30 of 2020. This change order extends the contract period to September 30, 2020 are targeted construction completion for which SecuraSite's services are required.

Further SecuraSite, as a service to C800 and to expedite jurisdictional filings and procurement of permits, has expended in excess of \$94,500 thus far in reimbursable expenses and anticipating an additional \$20,000. Part of this contract amendment is to add these reimbursable expenses to the contract.

FINANCE: The funds are budgeted in capital outlay as part of the Bond funding.

LEGAL: A C800 contract change order will be utilized as approved by legal counsel.

RECOMMENDATION: It is hereby recommended that the C800 Board of Directors approve issuing a contract amendment in the amount of \$80,000 to SecuraSite for additional site acquisition services.

RECOMMENDATION: It is hereby recommended that the C800 Board of Directors approve issuing a contract change order in the amount of \$119,382 for additional work at the Highland Butte site.
